Further, the views and opinions of students will provide valuable information for the academic staff and the administrators of a university to take informed decisions that will improve the students' learning experience.

The University of Sri Jayewardenepura (USJ) recognizes the importance of student engagement in quality assurance and this policy is devised to provide a basis for the current activities in the USJ in this respect.
